U. S. Mail selected application(s) to the Conference Level Designee, Postmarked no later than March 16, 2023.

CONFERENCE LEVEL

Mar. 19, 2024– April 23, 2024

Receive, review, select two (2) applications (if all criteria met).

U.S. Mail to the Episcopal Level Designee, Postmarked no later than April 26, 2024.
