Who is eligible to apply for The Promise?

The Promise is for graduating, first-time-in-college, high school seniors, who seek a degree in the fields of **Biology, Business, Communications, Criminal Justice, Elementary Education, Mathematics, Music, or Psychology.**

How do you qualify for The Promise?

- Complete the EWC admissions application for the fall 2018 term. **To apply, go to: www.ewc.edu.**

- Complete the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid Form (FAFSA)** and be eligible to receive the federal Pell grant with the estimated family contribution (EFC) of zero. FAFSA website: www.fafsa.ed.gov and EWC's FAFSA code: **001478.**
- Receive an acceptance letter from the EWC Office of Admissions.
- **Must be** a commuter student.
